

Parental consent for students aged under 18

We want to make sure that your child is safe and happy while studying in the UK. To help us, we ask you (the parent or legal guardian) to complete this form for any student aged under 18 who is enrolled at Brighton Language College.

Data Protection

Brighton Language College promises to keep this information secure and will only give it to people who are directly involved in caring for your child on a need to know basis during the time when they are enrolled at Brighton Language College; this may include healthcare and welfare professionals.

Travel

A completed [Medical Details & Consent to Travel Form](#) must be completed and sent to the school prior to departure.

The following permissions are given by the parent / legal guardian:

- Your son/daughter is to travel to the UK and study at the Brighton Language College.
- Your son/daughter is to travel unaccompanied between the school and his/her homestay.

Accommodation

Your son/daughter is staying in a homestay arranged by Brighton Language College.

He/she understands that he/she must follow the 'school and house rules'.

If your son/daughter is staying with family members or is in accommodation arranged by yourself, please provide full details to the school before arrival.

Curfew times

It is agreed that the following times when your son/daughter must return to their homestay

- Students aged 12 must be home by 9:30pm
- Students aged 13 - 15 must be home by 10:00pm
- Students aged 16 - 17 must be home by 11:00pm

Leisure activities

Permission is given for your son/daughter to go on any trips organised by Brighton Language College and to take part in these activities, under supervision.

Unsupervised time

Permission is given for your son/daughter to have free time for shopping on trips arranged by Brighton Language College.

Permission is given for your son/daughter to have unsupervised free time in Brighton during the time between the end of classes/activities and the time of the evening meal at their accommodation.

Permission is given for your son/daughter to have unsupervised free time in the evening after the evening meal and at weekends subject to curfews.

Medical

Please complete the [Medical Details & Consent to Travel Form](#). If we are not told in advance about a physical or mental condition, we reserve the right to terminate the student's course.

Attendance

Students are expected to attend all scheduled classes and activities and to be in their accommodation at the stated times.

If you wish your child to be absent from the course at any time, please contact the school directly so that suitable arrangements can be made.

Photographs and video clips

Brighton Language College may take photographs or video clips of students during class or leisure activities and that these images may be used in the school's publicity or on its social media site.

Students aged 16 and 17 who are enrolled on adult courses

It is understood that:

- Your son/daughter will come into regular contact with other students over the age of 18, in class and during the leisure programme
- he/she is responsible for buying their own lunch during the week
- there are certain British laws (e.g. related to smoking and drinking alcohol) that apply to people aged under 18. As a consequence, there may be some leisure activities which my son/daughter cannot take part in because of their age.
